What is Open Up?

Hello! I am Open Up counsellor.

- An online text-based emotional support platform
- Attentively addressing your diverse emotions and concerns
- Round the clock provides emotional support service for children and youth aged 6 to 24 residing in HK
- Protected under Hong Kong Law



What Personal Data will we collect?

- Your name
- Your phone number

Example:

- Ming is called Chan Tai Ming
 - 電話12345678

Why do we need to collect your personal data?

- Assist in evaluating and improving service quality
- Help us assess your safety and well-being
- Support other children and young people
- Conduct research, data analysis, and training

We will record this information to help and support other children and young people!



Will your data be protected?

- Protected by encryption
- Not used for marketing purposes
- Regularly monitoring by dedicated personnel to ensure safety and security

Example:

Like placing a secret in a safe, accessible only to trusted individuals with the key

- Caritas Hong Kong
- Hong Kong Children and Youth Services
- The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups
- St. James' Settlement

What rights do you have?

- You can voluntarily choose to provide data
- You can access, correct and delete your personal data

You are the owner of your own personal data!









Rules of Using Open Up

- Maintain politeness and avoid using offensive language
- Respect others and avoid causing harm
- Keep others' private information confidential
- Stay updated as rules may change

Open Up Rule

Adhering to the rules is essential!

- Maintain politeness
- Show respect to others
- Protect confidentiality
- Stay informed about updates

Example:

「Ming, please refrain from using profanity, as it may result in account suspension!」

Protecting others' personal data

Protecting others' information is extremely important!

- Do not share others' personal data without permission
- Obtain consent before sharing someone else's data and information

I am committed to protecting your personal data and will never share it lightly!

Protect your friends' personal data and information

Respect others' privacy





What should you do if you have a problem?

- Seek help from your parents.
- Ask teachers or trusted adults
- Review information from the Office of the Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data.










In case of emergency, call 999
